

Yamagata University International Exchange Photo Contest 2023

Yamagata University is holding a photo contest to spread the cross-cultural experiences of studying abroad, and the attractiveness of Yamagata University as a perspective of international students.

The Yamagata University International Exchange Photo Contest 2023 will accept entries in two categories: “Overseas Experiences” and “International Students”. The Overseas Experiences Category will be open to photos that capture the moments of experiencing different cultures through study abroad programs, such as short-term study abroad programs, undergraduate study abroad programs (including student ambassadors), as well as photos of landscapes that can only be seen in different countries. The International Students Category is looking for photos that depict the appeal of studying at Yamagata University as perceived by international students. Please feel free to participate.

1. Categories of entries

【Overseas Experience Category】

●Theme “My Global Experience”

- Memorable photos taken at study abroad destinations.
- Photographs that capture the enjoyment of the activities.

【International Students Category】

●Theme “My Life as an International Student in Yamagata”

- Photographs of university life at Yamagata University, part-time jobs, cross-cultural experiences, scenery, etc.
- Photographs of scenery and events that you would like to introduce to students who are coming to Yamagata University to study abroad.

2. Eligibility

Yamagata University students (including Short-term exchange students)

3. Submission period

From December 27, 2023 to February 22, 2024

4. Prizes

Overseas Experience Category

Grand Prize: QUO card worth 10,000 yen (1 person)

Second Prize: QUO Cards worth 5,000 yen each (2 people)

Honorable Mention Award: QUO Cards worth 3,000 yen each (3 people)

International Students Category

Grand Prize: QUO card worth 10,000 yen (1 person)

Second Prize: goes to two applicants, QUO Cards worth 5,000 yen each (2 people)

Honorable Mention Award: QUO Cards worth 3,000 yen each (3 people)

5. Entries

(1) Number of entries

Maximum of one photo per submission. Each applicant may submit up to two entries through both categories.

(2) Entry requirements

Any type of photographic equipment, color or black-and-white, portrait or landscape, is acceptable. Photographs that meet all of the following requirements will be accepted.

- Photographs must follow the theme of each category.
- Photographs must have been taken within the past three years.
- Photographs must be an original work taken by the applicants.
- If the subject is a person, the applicants must have the permission of the person (subject).
- The work must not have won any prizes in other contests in the past.
- The entry must not violate laws, ordinances, or public order and morals.

Entries can be submitted through the Yamagata University Exchange Platform website. Please follow the steps below to submit.

Please register as a "regular member" in order to submit.

② Post your entries to the "International Student Plaza" on the Exchange Platform.

Please follow the instructions below to submit your photos.

-Enter the title of the photo in the "Title" field.

- The title should be in both Japanese and English, or in either language.
- Please fill in (1) the place where the photo was taken (2) the program you participated in (Overseas Experience Category), and (3) episodes related to the photo, in the text field.

6. Announcement of Awards

The results will be announced on the Yamagata University website on Friday, March 15, 2024. The winners will be notified via e-mail or telephone regarding how to receive the prizes.
