Article 6: University fees and Scholarships

1 Entrance examination fees, admission fees and tuition fees

Entrance examination fees are payable at the time of submission of applications for entrance examinations. Admission fees are payable at the time of completion of the enrollment procedures. Apart from research students, tuition fees may be paid in installments after matriculation.

2 Exemption of admission fees and tuition fees

Concerning students who are acknowledged as having difficulty in paying the admission fees and tuition fees because of financial reasons and whose scholastic performance is excellent, if such students make a request, the university will examine their circumstances and may halve or waive their tuition fees, under an established scheme.

3 Scholarship information

Various organizations in Japan offer schemes to support international students, but the competition to receive scholarships is intense. Information about the offers of such scholarships will be provided on the University bulletin boards and website after matriculation.
