- · Applicants must take all EJU examination subjects that are specified by the faculty as shown in the table above. Only EJU result from 2020 2nd session in November is considered valid.
- Applicants must take Yamagata University's IAT as shown in the table above at Kojirakawa Campus (1-4-12 Kojirakawa-machi, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan). Applicants for Human Sciences and Culture Studies Course could take IAT at either Kojirakawa Campus or another location. The details will be available later.

■ Faculty of Education, Art and Science:

- Applicants must take all EJU examination subjects that are specified by the course as shown in the table above. Only EJU result from 2020 2nd session in November is considered valid.
- · Applicants must take Yamagata University's IAT as shown in the table above at Kojirakawa Campus (1-4-12 Kojirakawa-machi, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan).

Faculty of Science:

- Applicants must take all EJU examination subjects that are specified by the faculty as shown in the table above. Only EJU result from 2020 2nd session in November is considered valid.
- · Applicants must take a TOEFL® iBT test, TOEFL® paper-delivered test or TOEIC® Listening & Reading test. For TOEIC® Listening & Reading test, the test date must be April 2018 or later.

● Faculty of Medicine, Department of Medicine:

- Applicants must take all EJU examination subjects that are specified by the department as shown in the table above. Only EJU result from 2020 2nd session in November is considered valid. The acceptable score for "Japanese as a foreign language" is 380 or higher. The acceptable TOTAL score of "Science" and "Mathematics" is 330 or higher.
- Applicants must take a TOEFL® iBT test or TOEIC® Listening & Reading test. A minimum TOEFL® iBT score of 76 or a minimum TOEIC® Listening & Reading score of 700 is required. For TOEIC® Listening & Reading test, the test date must be April 2018 or later.
- · Applicants must take Yamagata University's IAT as shown in the table above at Iida Campus (2-2-2 Iida-Nishi, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan).

● Faculty of Medicine, Department of Nursing:

- Applicants must take all EJU examination subjects that are specified by the department as shown in the table above. Only EJU result from 2020 2nd session in November is considered valid. The acceptable score for "Japanese as a foreign language" is 280 or higher. The acceptable TOTAL score of "Science" and "Mathematics" is 250 or higher.
- Applicants must take a TOEFL® iBT test or TOEIC® Listening & Reading test. A minimum TOEFL® iBT score of 70 or a minimum TOEIC® Listening & Reading score of 650 is required. For TOEIC® Listening & Reading test, the test date must be April 2018 or later.
- · Applicants must take Yamagata University's IAT as shown in the table above at Iida Campus (2-2-2 Iida-Nishi, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan).

■ Faculty of Engineering:

- · Applicants must take all EJU examination subjects that are specified by the faculty as shown in the table above. Only EJU result from 2020 2nd session in November is considered valid.
- Applicants must take a TOEFL® iBT test or TOEIC® Listening & Reading test. A minimum TOEFL® iBT score of 39 or a minimum TOEIC® Listening & Reading score of 385 is required. For TOEIC® Listening & Reading test, the test date must be January 2018 or later.

● Faculty of Agriculture:

· Applicants must take all EJU examination subjects that are specified by the faculty as shown in the table above. Only EJU result from 2020 2nd session in November is considered valid.
