The screening of applicants will be done on the basis of:

- the 2018-19 academic year EJU results (applicants should specify which 2018-19 academic year EJU they took either June or November when filing application documents)
- the results of the Yamagata University IAT (the faculties of Science, Engineering, Daytime Courses and Agriculture require no IAT)
- screening of application documents

The following faculties, departments and courses have their own supplementary requirements, as follows.

• Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences:

Applicants must have sat all EJU subjects specified by the faculty (see the Table above) for the academic year 2018-19 taken in June or November. Applicants must sit IAT (see the Table above) at Kojirakawa Campus (4-12, Kojirakawa-machi 1-chome, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan). However, only the applicants of Human Sciences and Culture Studies course are going to choose the site to sit IAT either at Kojirakawa Campus or outside of the Campus (the details will be announced later).

• Faculty of Education, Art and Science:

Applicants must have obtained an average or higher score in all EJU subjects specified by the applicable course (see the Table above) for the academic year 2018-19 taken in June or November. Applicants must sit IAT (see the Table above) at Kojirakawa Campus (4-12, Kojirakawa-machi 1-chome, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan).

• Faculty of Science:

Applicants must have sat all EJU subjects specified by the faculty (see the Table above) for the academic year 2018-19 taken in June or November. In addition, applicants must have sat a TOEFL[®] TEST or TOEIC[®] TEST.

• Faculty of Medicine, Department of Medicine:

Applicants must have sat all EJU subjects specified by the department (see the Table above) for the academic year 2018-19 taken in June or November. The score of the subject of Japanese must have been 380 or higher and the total score of the subjects of Science and Mathematics must have been 330 or higher.

In addition, applicants must have sat a TOEFL[®] TEST or TOEIC[®] TEST. For the TOEFL[®] TEST, a score of at least 540 is required in the Paper-Based Test (PBT), or of at least 76 in the Internet-Based Test (iBT). For the TOEIC[®] TEST, a score of at least 700 is required.

Applicants must sit IAT (see the Table above) at Iida Campus (2-2, Iida-Nishi 2-chome, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan).

• Faculty of Medicine, Department of Nursing:

Applicants must have sat all EJU subjects specified by the department (see the Table above) for the academic year 2018-19 taken in June or November. The score of the subject of Japanese must have been 280 or higher and the total score of the subjects of Science and Mathematics must have been 250 or higher.

In addition, applicants must have sat a TOEFL[®] TEST or TOEIC[®] TEST. For the TOEFL[®] TEST, a score of at least 525 is required in the Paper-Based Test (PBT), or of at least 70 in the Internet-Based Test (iBT). For the TOEIC[®] TEST, a score of at least 650 is required.

Applicants must sit IAT (see the Table above) at Iida Campus (2-2, Iida-Nishi 2-chome, Yamagata City, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan).

• Faculty of Engineering, Daytime Courses:

Applicants must have sat all EJU subjects specified by the faculty (see the Table above) for the academic year 2018-19 taken in June or November. In addition, applicants must have sat a TOEFL® TEST or TOEIC® TEST. For the TOEFL® TEST, a score of at least 430 is required in the Paper-Based Test (PBT), or of at least 39 in the Internet-Based Test (iBT).

For the TOEIC® TEST, a score of at least 385 is required.

• Faculty of Agriculture:

Applicants must have sat all EJU subjects specified by the faculty (see the Table above) for the academic year 2018-19 taken in June or November.

In addition, applicants must have sat a TOEFL[®] TEST or TOEIC[®] TEST. For the TOEFL[®] TEST, a score of at least 410 is required in the Paper-Based Test (PBT), or of at least 34 in the Internet-Based Test (iBT). For the TOEIC[®] TEST, a score of at least 330 is required.
